COMMUNITY CHARGE: TRANSITIONAL RELIEF

The Prime Minister has seen your Secretary of State's minute of 9 October. She was content that the scheme for transitional relief in Wales should adopt a different structure from that in England. A scheme of the kind proposed should now be worked up in consultation with the Department of the Environment and the Treasury.
