HOLIDAY CARAVANS: STANDARD COMMUNITY CHARGE AND BUSINESS RATES

Thank you for copying to me your letter of 26 March to the Lord President.

Three things, I think, are clear. First, for perfectly comprehensible reasons, we have not fully met our commitments on the treatment of caravans under the new local government finance system. Secondly, the consequences of this for caravan owners, and for the industry, are substantial, and I do not think we can reasonably ask those affected to carry this additional burden. Third, the various possible solutions, short of legislation, which officials have considered, do not come near to meeting the industry's legitimate concerns.

It follows that I see no alternative to a Bill, and I therefore support your proposal. As you say, we must seek to ensure that the scope of the Bill is narrowly drawn, and the Instructions to Counsel will no doubt reflect that. I am not insensitive to the difficulties that further legislation on local government finance will bring - but I am convinced that we would face greater difficulties in the future if we failed to legislate now.
